- Think of one person who needs to know Jesus is the way, another person who needs to know Jesus is the truth and another person who needs to know Jesus is the life.

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Hebrews 13:8
- Matthew 24:35
- John 14:6

Read this passage carefully: John 14:1–11. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- Where is Jesus taking us to?
- How are Jesus and Daddy God related.

ACTIONS


Think of one person who needs to know Jesus is the way, another person who needs to know Jesus is the truth and another person who needs to know Jesus is the life. Write their name and their need on a large piece of paper and then pray for them.

GROUP ACTIVITY: TELL THE TRUTH

We all have things we want to do in the future. Each person in the group should say four things they want to do: three of them should be true and one of them should be made up. The rest of the group have to try and work out which one has been made up.

PUZZLE: FIND YOUR WAY

Can you find your way around this mini maze and mega maze?



GO AND DO IT: KEEP ON LIVING

See if you can keep moving without stopping for the next ten minutes without bumping into anyone.

EPISODE 2: DO NOT WORRY

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- > What things make you worry?
- When you start to worry, what can you do to remind yourself to stop worrying?

go deeper

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Matthew 6:25-34
- Psalm 2:4

Act out the story of Jonah and then read this passage carefully: Jonah 2:1–10. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- > What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:


- > Whose fault was it that Jonah was in the whale?
- Think of three different ways Jonah could have responded. Which way is the best way?
- Does God still listen to us if we mess up?

ACTIONS

Make a list of all the things that you have been worried about in the last week. Next to each item on the list write what Jesus would say about that worry. Pray together and ask Jesus to take all the worries away and to help you to trust him.

GROUP ACTIVITY: WATCH IT GO

- > Write some worries on a piece of paper in felt tip pen.
- > Turn the piece of paper into a boat.
- Fill up a bath with water and float the boat in the water until it sinks, or you get bored, or it is time for tea.
- Have your worries washed away? Take a look at the piece of paper to see.
- > Pull the baby out of the bath (if they've fallen in).



GO AND DO IT: I LOVE YOU

Think of somebody who worries a lot. Maybe they worry about whether or not you like them. If you can't think of anybody who worries, think of somebody who you want to make feel special. Create a card or make a letter to tell them how much they mean to you and how much you love them.

EPISODE 3: JESUS IS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- Jesus is the spiritual light. Make a list of things that are spiritually light and spiritual dark things. If you are creative draw some pictures to represent each one.
- > How can other people see that we love Jesus?

go deeper

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- John 8:1-12
- Psalm 119:105
- John 10:10
- John 16:12–15

Read this passage carefully: John 8:1–12. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- > What do we learn about God?
- > What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- In the podcast we heard that Jesus was the light of the world. What happened just before he said that?
- How does Jesus shine his light in the world today?

Actions


Think of three kind things you can do today that will show Jesus' light to others. Plan how you can do them.

GROUP ACTIVITY: MAKE SHADOWS

- > Shine a bright light on to a wall.
- > Take it in turns to make shadows on the wall to represent a Bible story.
- See if the rest of the group can work out which story you are trying to show in shadows.

PUZZLE: CLEAR THE SHADOWS

Which shadow matches each picture?



GO AND DO IT: YOUR OWN LANGUAGE

In the podcast Marty made up his own language. Why don't you make up your own language. It might be like English, but with extra sounds added into each word, or it might be that you make up your own words for different objects. So you call a chair a sitty-thingy and a bed a liey-thingy.

EPISODE 4: JESUS IS THE BREAD OF LIFE

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- In what ways is Jesus like bread (and in what ways is he different)?
- How do you eat the bread of life?

go deeper

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Exodus 16:1-36
- Luke 12:13–21
- John 6:1–14
- John 6:25–59
- Matthew 26:26-30

Read this passage carefully: Matthew 26:26–30. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- > Thinking of a king or queen, what is their kingdom?
- > What is God's kingdom?
- Where is God's kingdom?

Actions

Take communion together. Use some bread and red juice and take communion together. Thank God for what he did for you when he died on the cross to give you life. Copy what Jesus and his disciples did in Matthew 26 – after you have taken communion together sing a song.

GROUP ACTIVITY: EXPAND THE CIRCLE

- Find a soft ball and stand in a circle.
- One person throws the ball to someone else. If the ball is caught both people take a step forwards, if it is dropped both take a step backwards. See how big you can make the circle.

go deePer

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- John 15:1-8
- Romans 8:28

Read Acts 16:22–28 and then act it out *twice*. The first time you act it out, think what most people would do if they were in Peter and Silas' situation. Then act it again doing what they actually did. Ask yourself these questions about the passage:

- > What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- In verse 25 did Paul and Silas pray and worship so that they would be let out of prison?
- > Why did they pray and worship?
- How did Paul and Silas show Jesus fruit in their situation?

ACTIONS

Think of two things you can do to remain in Jesus then do those two things for the next ten minutes.

GROUP ACTIVITY: SPAGHETTI TREE


