GO DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

> Psalm 1:1-6

You could choose to draw a picture of today's Psalm. Read this passage carefully: Psalm 1. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- How can we read (meditate) on the Bible?
- ➤ Think about each line of verse 3 what would it look like if each of these things happen in your life.

ACTIONS

Choose one verse from the Bible and sit and think about it for 2 minutes (or longer if you are a bit older). After you have thought about it, share your thoughts together. You might choose to think about the last verse of this psalm: Psalm 1:6.

GROUP ACTIVITY: CODED MESSAGES

Can you create a coded message? Each person chooses a book and then uses the words in the book to send a message. You can all do it at the same time and then see how quickly you can decode it. For each word you will need to write down the following:

Read this passage carefully: Psalm 51:1–19. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- Look up the following words to understand what they mean in this psalm:
 - o Judge (vs 4)
 - o Spirit (vs 10)
 - Hyssop (vs 7)
 - Burnt offerings (vs 16)
 - Jerusalem (vs 18)
 - o Altar (vs 19)

ACTIONS


1 John 1:9 promises us that if we confess our sin God will forgive our sin. Take a moment to think about any sin in your life and say sorry to God for it. Take it in turns to read a verse from Psalm 51 as a prayer to God.


GROUP ACTIVITY: COLOUR HUNT

One person calls out a colour and everyone has to try and find an object in that colour as quickly as possible. To make the game a bit more challenging, call colours by objects — for example, snow would mean something white, sun something yellow, sky something blue. WARNING— you don't need to collect the object. Please do not try to collect the sun. Our scientists have assessed this activity and have found that there is a severe risk of burns if you touch the sun.

Read this passage carefully: Psalm 42. Ask one person to read it out loud. Everyone else can act out the words of this psalm.

Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

Can we trust God when things are going wrong?

ACTIONS

Think about the words you say to yourself, how many of them line up with what God wants you to think? This is all part of us taking captive every thought as it says in 2 Corinthians 10:5

Think of something you are finding hard at the moment — what thoughts go round your head. Perhaps: 'I can't do this.' Or 'When will it end!'


Pause for a moment to worship God and then tell yourself to trust God, like the Psalmist does.

GROUP ACTIVITY: I THINK YOU ARE ...

Go round each member of your family. Tell each person one thing that you like about them (it must be nice!) When one person has said something, the next person should include that phrase in what they say. So, the first person may say, 'I think you are caring.' The next person has to say I think you are caring and clever.'

- What is a shepherd's rod and staff used for (verse 4) and how can it comfort us?

ACTIONS

You could even turn your list into your very own psalm of praise to God.


GROUP ACTIVITY: HIDE AND SHEEP

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- This Psalm praises God for who he is and for what he does.
 - Make a list of the things that describe who God is in this Psalm, then add anything else you know about God to the list.
 - Make a list of the things that this psalm says God does, then add anything else you know God does to the list.
- Find all the verbs (the doing words) in this psalm to discover how God wants us to come to him.

ACTIONS

Have a praise party at home – celebrate and praise God together.

GROUP ACTIVITY: PARTY TIME

Have a special party celebration together as a family today. Do as many 'treat' things as you can in a day.

PUZZLE: LOST IT FOUND IT

Adrian has lost his guitar – can you help him find it?



GO AND DO IT: MAKE YOUR OWN

Make your own instruments that you can use to praise God. You might make a shaker or an elastic band guitar. Check online for some more ideas.
