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EPISODE 6: FAITH DEFINED

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- Can you think of any example of people acting by faith?
- What is possible by faith?

Go DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Hebrews 11:1

Read this passage carefully: 2 Kings 4:1–7. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What was the widow's need?
- If the widow did not believe God was speaking through Elisha what would she have done differently?
- The widow had to use her ears and her hands to see a miracle. Think about how we have to use our ears and hands to act by faith and see God move.

ACTIONS

Talk about a problem you are facing which seems impossible. What does God want to happen in this situation? What do you need to do about it? Step out in faith.

ACTIVITIES

GROUP ACTIVITY: THE TRUST FALL

One person stands behind another. The person in the front closes their eyes and falls backwards – will they trust that the person behind them will catch them or will they move their feet and open their eyes before they are caught?

PUZZLE: THE HALL OF FAITH

Each clue in this crossword is a verse from Hebrews chapter 11. Write the person of faith as the answer to the clue. Be careful: there are six people from verse 32 – do all the other clues first and then see if you can work out where to put each of their names.

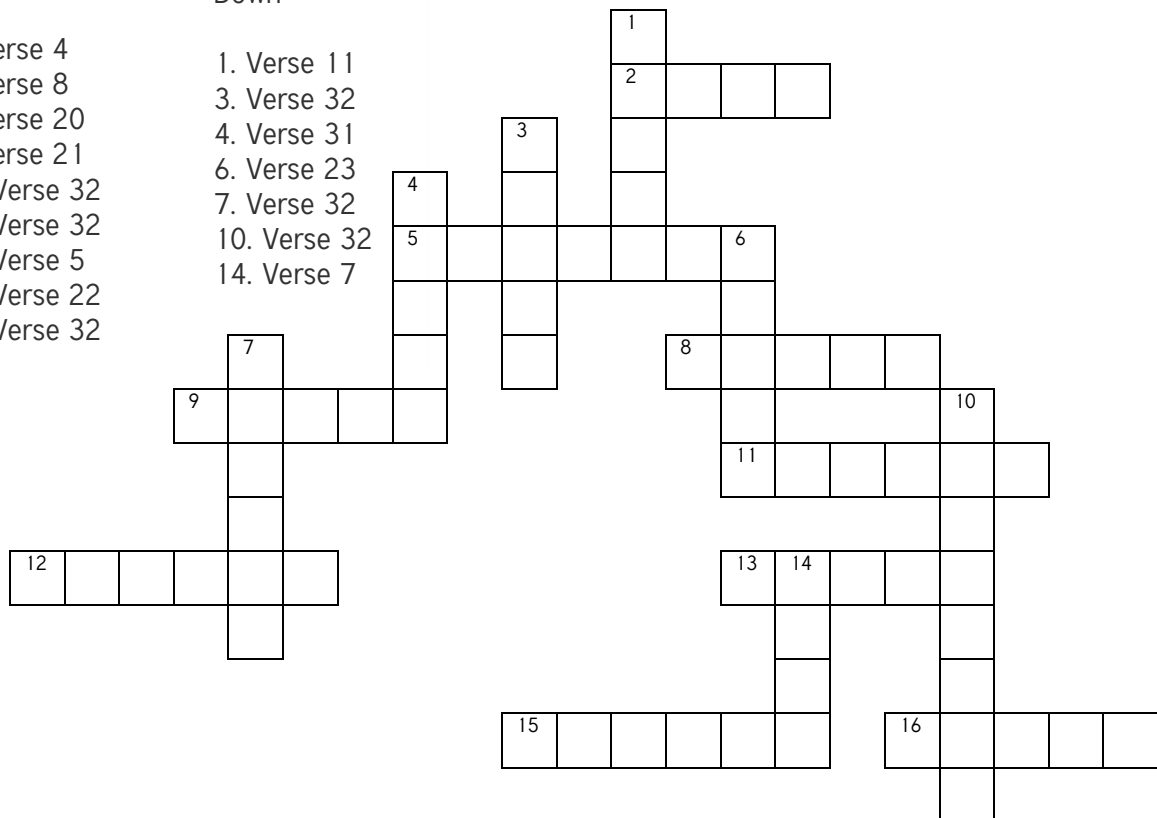

Go AND Do IT: GOD DID IT

Decorate a notebook to keep a record of all the things that God has done for you and your family. You might record things by writing them down, drawing a picture or sticking in something to remember what God did (like the receipt from a free meal he gave you).

EPISODE 7: PLEASING GOD

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- Why is it impossible to please God without faith?
- What does it look like when someone has faith?

Go DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Hebrews 11:1-6
- Romans 4:3

Read this passage carefully: Genesis 22:1-19. You might want to act it out as you read it. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What would have other people have thought about Abraham if they knew what he planned to do?
- How can we be sure God if it is God speaking to us?

ACTIONS

Ask God for one thing he wants you to do – this may be linked to something you are asking God for or it may be something totally different. It may be something God wants you to change or somebody God wants you to help. Make sure you do what he asks you to do today.

ACTIVITIES

GROUP ACTIVITY: EGG DROP

You will need an egg, straws, masking tape and other packaging materials. Use the materials to build a structure on the floor that can catch an egg. When you have finished, see if it will catch an egg from the height of the tallest person, without cracking.

Read this passage carefully: 2 Timothy 3:16–17. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- Make up an action for each of the four things mentioned in verse 16 that Scripture does.
- Examine verse 17 – Think who does Scripture affect, in what way, for what purpose.

ACTIONS

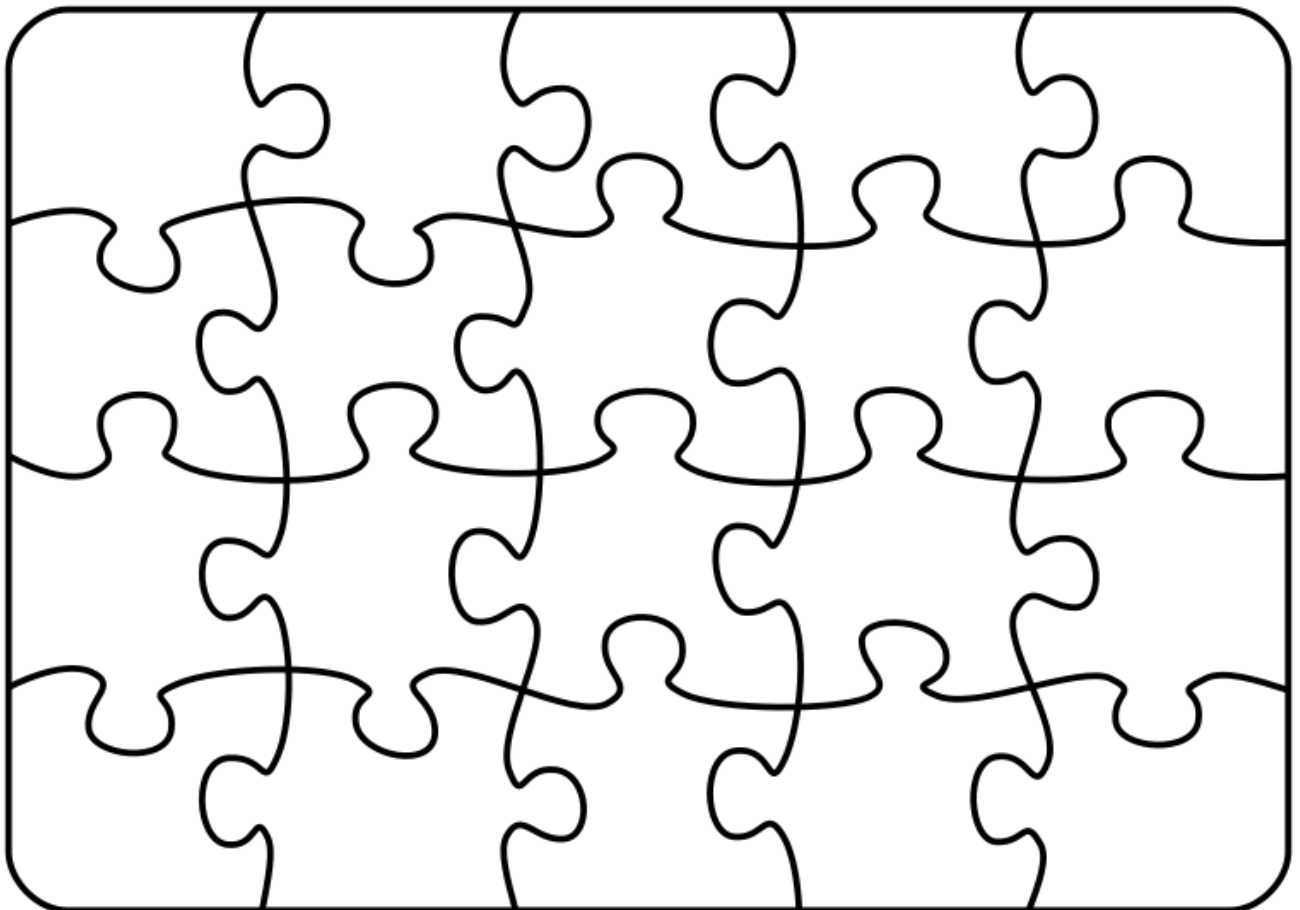
Read the Bible every day. Download or create a Bible reading plan for the next month and mark off as you read it each day.

ACTIVITIES**GROUP ACTIVITY: SILENT CHARADES**

Choose one person to start. They must think of the title to a book, movie or song to act out. Using only actions they have two minutes to act out the title while others try to guess. If you have eight or more people, create two teams to play against each other.

PUZZLE: JIGSAW

Create your own jigsaw using the template below. You could draw a picture of your face (but don't draw on your face.) Print the template on card, then draw and colour a picture on it. When you have finished, cut along the lines and enjoy making and remaking your very own jigsaw puzzle.

**Go AND Do IT: DINNER TIME**

In today's story, Simon loved sausages. His three favourite meals were: Sausage and mash, sausage casserole or sausage crumble. Look up the recipe for one of these meals in a book or on the internet then make it for dinner.

EPISODE 9: FAITH IN THE STORM

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- What kind of storms do people face in life?
- How can you rejoice when bad things happen?

Go DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Romans 5:1–5
- James 1:2–8
- John 9:1–12

Act out all of John chapter 9, then read this part carefully: John 9:35–41. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What does Jesus mean by seeing people will become blind?
- Why does Jesus say the Pharisees are guilty?
- What did the blind man do differently to the Pharisee and how can you copy him?

ACTIONS

Find someone who is going through a hard time. Make a card for them and give it to them then offer to pray for them and expect God to change things in their life.

ACTIVITIES

GROUP ACTIVITY: MAKE A STORM

Sit in a circle with one person as the leader. When the leader does an action the person sitting to their left has to copy them and so on until everyone is doing the same action. Then when the leader chooses they can switch to the next action and watch it change around the circle.

These are the actions for the leader to do in order: 1. Silence, 2. Rub hands (Wind), 3. Pat thighs (Light rain), 4. Snap fingers (Rain showers), 5. Clap hands (Heavy rain), 6. Stomp feet and clap hands (Thunder), 7. Clap hands (Heavy rain), 8. Snap fingers (Rain showers), 9. Pat thighs (Light rain), 10. Rub hands (Wind), 11. Silence.

GO AND DO IT: BOAT IN THE STORM

Paint a picture of a storm. At the very bottom of the picture staple blue paper with a wavy line. Cut out and decorate a small boat and stick it onto a craft stick. Then paint a picture of a storm on a large piece of paper.

When the picture has dried, make a blue piece of paper the same width as your picture, but a quarter of the height. Cut it with a wavy line at the top and staple it either side of your picture at the bottom. Then put the stick of the boat in the gap in between the wave and the storm and make it sail.

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- How do our emotions and feelings help us?
- How can we make sure we are led by the Holy Spirit?

GO DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Galatians 5:17–18
- Romans 8:14
- John 15:14

Read this passage carefully: Acts 16:6–10. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What places did Paul and his friends not go to and why?
- How did the Holy Spirit show them they should go to Macedonia?
- How do you think the Holy Spirit stopped them from going places?

ACTIONS

Take a moment to listen to the Holy Spirit. Start by worshipping God with a song (don't just sing it, but sing it to God). Then close your eyes, keep thinking about God and ask him if there is something he wants you to do. Wait for a moment and see if any thoughts pop into your head.

Don't forget to act on anything the Holy Spirit says to you.

ACTIVITIES

GROUP ACTIVITY: LAST SUNDAY I ...

The first person starts with this phrase: Last Sunday I ... then they add one action (like brushed my teeth, ate my breakfast, read the Bible, etc.). The next person repeats what they said and adds one more action to the list.
