DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- What do you think God means when he says you are a new creation?
- How does being new change you?

GO DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- 2 Corinthians 5:17
- Romans 8:18-25

Read this passage carefully: 2 Corinthians 5:16–21. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- How should we now think about other people (vs16)?
- How did we become a new creation (vs 18-19)?
- What are we called to be now that we are a new creation (vs20)?

AcTionS

Have a crazy time of thanking God for all he has done for us. You may want to take in turns to thank God, or all shout out thanks to God together. Try to have different themes for thankfulness. Thank God for:


- > Who he is.
- What he has done for us.
- His promises in the Bible.
- The people he has put around us.
- > The things he has given us.

GROUP ACTIVITY: NEW SONGS AND MOVIES

Take the titles of ten songs or movies and change one word to show new creation thinking. For example instead of Infinity War – Infinity Calls.

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- What makes your family different to other families?
- What makes God's family different to other families?

GO DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Romans 8:12-17
- ➤ Galatians 4:1-7
- ▶ 1 John 3:1-3

Read this passage carefully: Matthew 9:20–22. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

Did you know that in Bible times, if someone was bleeding they were not allowed to touch anybody — they were counted as unclean. Now you know this you might want to ask these questions too:

- How would the crowd have acted around the lady?
- What do you think people thought when the realized that the woman had touched Jesus?
- What did Jesus call the lady and why?

ACTIONS

Take 37 seconds to speak to Father God and tell him what is on your heart as his child. Then use 21 second to listen to Father God and hear what he wants you to do.

GROUP ACTIVITY: FAMILY QUIZ

This activity involves asking questions where the answer will be someone in your family. For example: Who spends the longest in the bathroom? If you find a toy on the floor who is it most likely to belong to? Each person thinks of around 5 questions and write them down if they can. Then put the questions in a hat and pull them out one by one. Then each person writes down (or points to) the member of the family they think best answers the question. Have fun (and be kind)!

GO DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

Romans 7:7-25

Read this passage carefully: Mark 10:17–22. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What did the man say he had done since he was a boy?
- What did Jesus say he should do?
- Which is more important, being good or following Jesus?
 - Think a bit more can you be good without following Jesus? Can you follow Jesus without being good? If you are good will you follow Jesus more? If you follow Jesus will you become more good? This is a deep question, but it will give you a chance to talk about grace, salvation by faith alone and also James' instructions how our faith will lead to works.

ACTIONS


Write two lists: One of the old you — the kind of things that you do that do not please God and the other of the new you — the kind of things you do that match up to who God made you to be. Remember a lot of this is to do with what our heart's desires are. Bring the lists to God in prayer.

GROUP ACTIVITY: WE'VE GOT TALENT

Hold a talent show in your family. Have a prize ready for the winner. May the best person win and may home and may you all cheer each other on and may you all eat ice cream.

GO AND DO IT: UPCYCLE

Find something old and make it new. I don't mean your grandparents. It might be something that is going to be thrown out or a piece of furniture. Check with your parents first though, you don't want to end up ruining their priceless antiques (I still don't mean your grandparents).

GO DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- Matthew 28:16-20
- 2 Timothy 3:14-17
- Acts 1:4-8

Read this passage carefully: Mark 16:16–18. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What did Jesus tell his disciples to do?
- Who is supposed to go?
- Where are they supposed to go?
- What will happen when people believe?

ACTIONS

Is there a country that you feel God wants you to go to to tell people about him (it may be the country you live in). Start to learn about the country today. Here are some ideas:


- Pray fro the country.
- Find it on a map.
- Learn some words in the language.
- Cook and eat some of the food people in the country typically eat.
- Find out how many people know about Jesus there and what challenges they face.

GROUP ACTIVITY: WORLD EXPERIENCE DAY

Have a day where you enjoy eating food from different cultures and dressing up in different clothes. How many different languages can you say hello in?

Print a copy of the world map and colour all the countries where you know somebody who is following Jesus. You may want to include a photo of them or find another creative way to remember them by. This can be your prayer board as you pray for the nations of the world.

DISCUSS

- What did you discover from today's podcast?
- Think of things that Jesus did and talk about how we can copy him.
- What one area would you like to grow more in copying Jesus?

GO DEEPER

These Bible verses were mentioned in today's podcast.

- ➤ Matthew 7:15-29
- Galatians 5:22-26
- Mark 16:14-20

Read this passage carefully: John 14:11–17. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- Why does Jesus tell his disciples to believe him?
- What does he promise we will be able to do?
 - Note we can't do greater things than Jesus, but when the whole church works together we will be able to do more things than Jesus, as one person, could do when he walked on the earth.
- Who has Jesus sent to help us?

AcTionS


Take it in turns to pray for each member of the family to be filled with the Holy Spirit.
