- What is the fruit of God's kingdom?
- How are you sowing seeds in your life?

ACTIONS

GROUP ACTIVITY: GAMES FOR GIANTS


Use some large boxes as a wall to play giant Jenga.

Read this passage carefully: Matthew 13:45–46. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What was the man doing when he found the pearl of great price?
- How are you looking for God's kingdom?

ACTIONS

What has God given you — talents, money, time, etc. Talk about how you can use some of each of these things for searching after more of God's kingdom ... then do it.

GROUP ACTIVITY: OBJECT HUNT

Each person selects three objects and has to hide it somewhere in the house. Then go object hunting — the person who finds the most hidden objects wins.

You might want to ask these questions too:

- What is 'the world' in this passage (the planet, the people, the way of thinking)?
- In what way(s) are we in the world?
- How are we not of the world?
- Jesus sends us into the world, how can we impact it (think about the yeast in today's devotional)?

ACTIONS


Call one person today who you have not spoken to for a while and have a chat with them to bring a bit of God's kingdom to them.

GROUP ACTIVITY: SILLY SONGS

Write the names of ten songs that everyone knows on ten pieces of paper and do the same for ten names of famous people (may be fictional) or animals. Put the two lists into two separate bowls. Each person has to choose one song and one person, they then have to sing the song in the style of that person or animal.

PUZZLE: WORDLADDER PUZZLE

Start with the word at the top of the ladder and work your way down to the bottom of the ladder. On each step you must replace 1 letter of the word – you can change the order of the other letters.

Read and act out this passage carefully: Matthew 20:1–16. Whenever you study the Bible it is always good to ask these questions about the passage:

- What do we learn about God?
- What do we learn about people?
- What does God want me to ask or think from this passage?

You might want to ask these questions too:

- In what ways do some people join the labour field later in the day?
- In what ways are we all equal in God's kingdom?
- What does Jesus mean by the first will be last and the last will be first?

ACTIONS

Think what we learn about God and what we are reminded about ourselves from today's passage.

Use these thoughts to praise God that he is bigger than us and fairer than us.

GROUP ACTIVITY: WHAT'S THE TIME

Play 'What's the time Mr Wolf' (also known as 'Grandmother's footsteps') — creeping up on one person to see if you can touch them before they get you.

PUZZLE: SPOT THE DIFFERENCE

- When we have received the kingdom of God what difference does it make to us and those around us?

Choose a key of God's kingdom to unlock something in your family's life. Take the Bible verse to God and use it in your prayers today.


GROUP ACTIVITY: AT HAND


PUZZLE: UNLOCK THE CODED MESSAGE
