Actions


Follow the stop model of prayer together: Sorry – Thank you – Others – Please (praying for yourself) then listen to what God wants to speak to you through the Bible and his Holy Spirit.

GROUP ACTIVITY: CHARADES

Play a game of charades – where you have to mime the names of films or books without using words while others try to guess what you are doing. If you are unfamiliar with this game you can look up instruction online.

Create a prayer journal where you can write down the things you are praying for and how God answers you.

EPISODE 37: READ THE BIBLE

DISCUSS

- > What did you discover from today's podcast?
- > How does the Bible help us while we are on earth?
- > Which book of the Bible do you think is a good place to start?

GO DEEPER

- In what way are they different (not their houses, but them as people)?
- What effect did this have on their houses?

ACTIONS

Find a passage of the Bible to pray over your family. It may be the blessing from Numbers 6:24–26 or the words in Philippians 1:9–11.

GROUP ACTIVITY: SWORD DRILL

Each person will need their own Bible. One person calls out a Bible reference and everyone else has to race to find it. Give a head start to different members of their family, based on their age.

- > Discuss what it means to worship God in spirit.


Actions

Actions



You might want to ask these questions too:

- How should we treat each other?
- What is the most important part in God's body?

ACTIONS

Arrange an online worship session with another family.

GROUP ACTIVITY: DRAWING PEOPLE

Give each person a piece of paper, folded across the width of the paper into four sections.

In the top section each person draws a head and neck. Make sure the two lines of the neck extend slightly into the next section. Fold the head and neck so it cannot be seen and pass the paper to the next person. In the next section someone draws the arms and body before folding and passing it on. The third section is for the legs and the final section is for the feet. When you have drawn all the people open them up to see what they look like.
